

HIGHFIELDS

Red Frogs continues to be a vital part of how we love, serve, and safeguard the next generation — showing up in some of the most unexpected and influential spaces across Toowoomba, Gatton, and beyond.

Every week, volunteer teams are on the ground in university colleges, building relationships of trust and creating a safe, caring presence.
From Thursday nights in dorms, to major local events like Weetwood, Schoolies, afterparties, and the CMC Rocks Festival, Red Frogs offers early intervention, triage, and vital support. Through their consistent presence, Red Frogs offers more than just safety - they bring genuine care and connection.

Our reach also goes far beyond parties. We're active in high schools,

boarding houses, businesses, sports teams like Western Clydesdales and Toowoomba Mountaineers, and beyond – bringing reliable support, wisdom, and compassion into places the Church might never otherwise go.

Through Expansion, your giving will:

- Resource our current programs in schools, universities, sports, skateparks and festivals that keep Red Frogs operational and effective.
- Enable new opportunities locally like new boarding house programs, events support, training and outreach to local schools.
- Equip more volunteers to carry the love of Jesus into new places.

BEAUTIFUL CRAZY

A single phone call can transform an ordinary day into one filled with uncertainty and fear. For families with a loved one in ICU life can shift in an instant, with no time to prepare and no idea how long they'll be sitting in that waiting room.

That's where Beautiful Crazy steps in. Founded by INC Chairman Pastor Ross Abraham and his family after the tragic loss of their son and brother Jaaden in 2024, this incredible initiative exists to care for families during their most difficult days. Just days before his accident, Jaaden described his life as a balance of both "beautiful and crazy", and through this movement his legacy continues to bring hope to others.

In partnership with major hospitals across Queensland, New South Wales, and Victoria, Beautiful Crazy delivers thoughtfully prepared gift bags filled with essentials designed to meet physical, emotional, and mental needs for those waiting at the bedside of someone they love.

As Highlands, we want to love and care for people, especially in their

worst moments, not just with words, but with compassion that takes action. That's why we're partnering with Beautiful Crazy through Expansion, with a goal to provide 200 ICU support bags for families in our region.

Each bag is more than just a gesture. It's a lifeline, reminding someone in crisis and grief that they are seen, they are not alone, and that love and community are surrounding them.

Together, we can extend hope and comfort where it's needed most, one story at a time.

CONVOY OF HOPE

Disasters don't wait for the right moment – they interrupt lives suddenly and without warning. In just the first half of 2025, Convoy of Hope has already responded to 36 disasters globally. including cyclones and catastrophic flooding across Queensland and New South Wales.

In those moments of crisis, Convoy shows up fast, not just with empathy, but with action. Their teams provide emergency accommodation, clean water, hot meals, clean-up kits, and compassionate support.

One local NSW pastor said it best:

"When help arrived, it lifted a weight we didn't even realise we were carrying. In that moment, it was just knowing we weren't alone. That kind of relief gives you the strength to keep going."

Through Expansion, Highlands is committed to sowing financially into Convoy of Hope, so they can continue to be the hands and feet of Jesus when disaster strikes, here in Australia and around the world. But beyond finances, there's also an opportunity for us to go and serve when needed.

GLOBAL MISSION

VIETNAM

Through Expansion in 2024, Highlands partnered with the growing network of INC churches across Vietnam, supporting over 90 churches, educational initiatives, and development projects that are lifting communities from survival to strength.

This year, we'll continue sowing in — including the ongoing outworking of a vital clean water project, support for educational programs, and

further development of local churches in both rural and urban areas.



MISSIONARIES

Through Expansion, we're honoured to support two incredible missionary families who are making a tangible difference across the globe.

Christine Brodie serves as a Literacy and Education Advisor in the Asia-Pacific, helping children gain lifelong learning skills and the ability to read Scripture in their own language opening doors not just to education, but to the gospel.

Nick and Suzanne Veltiens serve on Mercy Ships in Madagascar, providing life-changing medical care to vulnerable children. Nick specialises in treating 'clubfoot' and is mentoring local professionals in this area, so that this care can continue long after the ship departs.

By partnering with Highlands missionaries, you are helping transform futures and spread the hope of Jesus to the ends of the earth.

COMPASSION

The Compassion Survival Project steps into a critical window from pregnancy through to a child's first birthday.


Through Expansion, Highlands has the opportunity to fund a 12-month Survival Project near Manado, Indonesia, that delivers tailored, practical care. This includes medical assistance, nutrition, birth support, and discipleship for mothers.

These projects are vital because traditional child sponsorship through Compassion begins once a child turns one, making this an incredible opportunity to fulfill urgent needs that would otherwise go unmet. By investing at this foundational stage, we're not only addressing physical needs, but helping release families

> from the cycle of poverty in Jesus' name. Not iust as children grow, but even before they are born.

OUR LEGACY SO FAR

We've seen God do amazing things thanks to the generosity and faith of our Church. Here's a snapshot of what's been happening in our local, national and alobal communities over the last 12 months.

CHURCH PROJECTS & NEXT GEN

MIDDLE RIDGE KIDS SPACES

Since Expansion 2024, we've created new, agespecific spaces at Highlands Middle Ridge that have unlocked deeper discipleship and stronger connection for our youngest generation. The transformation has been clear; with leaders, parents, and kids all celebrating the difference. Throughout 2025, Middle Ridge has been seeing over 940 people gathering weekly, including an average of 178 children actively engaged in our Kids Ministry each week.

HIGHFIELDS ENUIRONMENT UPGRADES We have invested in updating our Kids and Youth spaces at Highlands Highfields — enhancing safety and creating a more welcoming experience for families. This, combined with a growing connection through Small Groups, has fueled consistent growth. Today, over 320 people gather weekly at Highfields, supported by 38 active Small Groups that are building authentic community and spiritual formation.

GATTON LAUNCH RESOURCES

Through Expansion, we've helped launch Highlands Gatton's monthly gatherings by resourcing production equipment, Kids Ministry materials, signage, décor, youth transportation, and staffing. In 2025, Highlands Gatton has consistently gathered over 100 people across Sunday services and Friday Youth, laying strong foundations for a thriving future.

LOCAL MISSION

YOUTH CAMPS & SMALL GROUPS Because of Expansion 2024, we were able to support hundreds of teenagers from each Highlands location to attend life-shaping events like My Youth Camp, Summercamp, and Awaken. Each Friday during the school term, more than

220 students gather to encounter God, grow in faith, and be equipped to make a lasting impact both now, and in the future.

RED FROGS

In 2024, Red Frogs were able to extend their reach and deepen their impact – showing up in the spaces where young people need support the most.

Thanks to your generosity through Expansion, Red Frogs were able to:

Serve weekly across seven university colleges at UniSQ Toowoomba and UQ Gatton.

Attend 17 afterparties, offering real-time care, safety, and connection.

Deliver five high school education programs, equipping students with life and leadership skills.

Provide ongoing sport support to the Western Clydesdales and Toowoomba Mountaineers.

Build strong partnerships with local businesses and offer consistent support in two high school boarding houses.

Send a dedicated team of Highlanders to serve at Schoolies on the Gold Coast.

Support major local events like Weetwood. Warwick Rodeo, and CMC Rocks Festival, as well as six additional festivals in Brisbane.

HIGHFIELDS CAMPUS

Throughout 2024, we continued critical behindthe-scenes work toward our future Highfields Campus – partnering with government authorities, architects, and builders to move the project forward with diligence and prayer.

NATIONAL MISSION

SOCIETY CHURCH MELBOURNE

In 2024, we sowed a \$20,000 gift into the launch of Society Church – helping fund essential equipment and initial staffing. Since launching,

the church has begun gathering weekly and is already seeing people connect to Jesus and discover community for the very first time.

YOUNG LEADER DEVELOPMENT

Through Expansion, over 50 emerging pastors and leaders from across Australia have received training and resources, helping to raise a new generation of strong, gospel-centred leadership.

INC NATIONAL SUPPORT

Expansion continues to enable the strengthening of the broader INC movement across Australia. In 2024, we contributed to Christian Heritage College's most successful year to date and helped establish an Education Board to oversee all four INC Colleges. We also played a key role in developing and coaching leaders across the network, including offering guidance toward the planning of a potential new Christian school in Perth.

We continued to support INC Network Plus churches, providing resources, mentoring, and strategic input to help smaller and developing churches grow in health, strength, and long-term impact.

GLOBAL MISSION

In Vietnam, we supported over 90 INC churches with training and development, while also funding clean water projects in remote areas. These wells are being strategically placed by local pastors to meet urgent needs and open doors for ministry.

We also continued to help the development of a new church and school in Switzerland, providing coaching, leadership development, and strategic support to establish strong foundations for the future.

This is more than practical help for now – it's investing in global legacy through healthy leaders, thriving churches, and lasting transformation.
